Dear Parents and Carers

Update Following Consultation on Proposed School Uniform Changes

I am writing to inform you of some important updates regarding our school uniform policy, which will come into effect from **September 2025**.

After careful consideration and consultation, we have decided to implement new uniform expectations. This decision has been made to promote a greater sense of unity, discipline, and pride within our school community, as well as to ensure consistency and a professional appearance for all students.

Some key points on the uniform policy from September 2025 are as follows:

- All students will be required to wear a **black sweater embroidered with the school logo**
- The **year specific school tie** will be a compulsory item for all students, to be worn correctly at all times
- Shirts/blouses must be plain white and tucked in
- Trousers must be plain black with no denim or fashion elements - no leggings or jersey fabric
- Footwear will be limited to plain black, shoes, or trainers with no visible branding
- Hair accessories and headscarves must be black. No other head coverings are permitted, including durags (do-rags).
- Students should only have natural hair colour and no extreme haircuts.
- Other than a wristwatch, no costume jewellery may be worn. Students with pierced ears may wear one pair of small plain gold or silver studs (one stud per ear in the lower lobe, looped earrings are not allowed).
- No facial and body piercings are acceptable.
- Make up should be minimal and natural, fake eyelashes & false nails are not allowed in the academy.
- The PE kit will remain the same until September 2026 for years 8-11.

Uniform will be sold via ParentPay on our website and will be available for collection from school at allotted times.

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
