**Re: Year 11 After-School Intervention Programme**

As part of our ongoing commitment to supporting Year 11 in preparation for their GCSE examinations, we will be running a two-week intervention timetable. These sessions are a vital part of exam preparation, designed to give students targeted subject support, opportunities to revisit key content, and the chance to develop exam skills and confidence.

- **Green Week** will focus on the core subjects: English, Maths and Science.
- **Blue Week** will provide opportunities for other subjects to run interventions.
- Supervised Independent Revision areas will also be available to students on any day that there is no intervention running. Students are required to bring their own revision to these sessions.

All sessions will run from 3.00–4.00pm after school, beginning on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> September with Green Week.

We cannot overstate the importance of regular attendance at these interventions. Students who engage consistently give themselves the very best chance of achieving their target grades in the summer examinations. These sessions are not optional extras; they are an essential part of Year 11 provision, and we expect students to attend as many sessions relevant to them as possible.

Attendance at intervention will also contribute towards Year 11's "Passport to Prom". Each half-term, students can earn up to three badges:

- one for maintaining 90% attendance,
- one for achieving a 90% behaviour ratio,
- one for collecting 90 intervention points (with each intervention session worth five points).

Across the year, students need to collect 10 out of a possible 15 badges to be eligible to attend the Year 11 Prom. This means that regular participation in intervention is not only vital for exam success but also forms part of the pathway to celebrating their achievements at the end of the year.

Your encouragement and support in ensuring your child attends every session is crucial. By working together, we can help them make the most of these opportunities and approach their exams with confidence.
