Re: Final trip details - London

We are pleased to be able to share the final information for the London Trip with you. There is also the confirmed itinerary on the final page.

Food

Day 1 – Wednesday 15th July

I would advise that your child has something to eat for **breakfast** before arriving to school in the morning. We will be stopping at the services for a toilet break approximately halfway to London. This will be approximately 10am (dependant on traffic). Students will have the opportunity to buy food/snacks at the services but a gentle reminder that the services can be expensive. Students need to bring **a packed lunch and snacks** for day one.

Breakfast - Have at home - bring some food to have on the coach/ option to buy food at services

Lunch - Packed lunch

Dinner - Pizza Express

Day two – Thursday 16th July

Breakfast – provided by the hotel.

Lunch – we will be visiting Covent Garden and the area around it – students will have the chance to buy lunch from one of the many food outlets there.

Dinner – We will be stopping at the services on the way back. Students will have the opportunity to buy food there.

Weather

Please make sure you have provided clothes appropriate for the weather. As this is a school trip can I remind you of expectations around clothes needing to be appropriate. No short shorts, low cut tops, or tops that show midriff. Also, no offensive language on clothing.

Please make sure students have sensible footwear they can walk in. As we know the weather in the UK can be unpredictable so please make sure you have also packed something warm, just in case. We recommend your child brings some **suncream**.

Water

The weather is going to be hot in London so please send your student with plenty to drink. We need all students to stay hydrated.

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Medication

Please can you make sure any medication that your child needs is clearly labelled with their name and clear instructions for dosage and times needed. This should be handed in to Mrs Simpson on arrival to school.

Spending Money

As stated above students will need to buy two meals during the trip plus any snacks. They will have the opportunity for some shopping at Covent Garden market.

I would advise a budget of £10-£15 per meal, and a small amount of spending money.

Students will be responsible for their own spending money.
